What Quality Improvement (QI) activity can a dentist claim?

Please note that **five hours of QI activity per dentist is the maximum available**, even if a dentist works across different practices and participates in more than one survey.

Time is running out. You must register now to make sure your team have enough time to complete the survey by **Tuesday 31 March 2020**.
