## Preventive and Periodontal Care - Draft

Enhanced preventive advice and treatment

- Extensive preventive care advice and treatment which must include:
  - o oral hygiene instruction;
  - o tooth brushing and interdental cleaning demonstrations;
- It may also include, where appropriate:
  - o alcohol and smoking cessation advice;
  - dietary advice;
  - o application of topical fluoride;
  - Professional Mechanical Plaque Removal (PMPR) of supragingival calculus.
- This item cannot be claimed alongside an examination, review examination; fluoride varnish, fissure sealant or silver diamine; periodontal assessment and treatment (standard); or periodontal assessment and treatment (enhanced).
- This item cannot be claimed more than once in 6 months.

## Fluoride varnish, fissure sealants or silver diamine

- This item may include:
  - the application of fluoride varnish;
  - the application of fissure sealants, as a primary preventive measure, to pits and fissures of unfilled third molar teeth within 2 years of their eruption; or
  - the application of topical fluoride preparations to all teeth, or sliver diamine for individual teeth, for patients with diagnosed caries, who show evidence of a high risk of rapidly advancing dental caries due to exceptional medical or dental conditions or because of behavioural or habitual problems.
- This can only be claimed once in every 6 months.
- This item cannot be claimed alongside enhanced preventive advice and treatment.

## Periodontal assessment and treatment (standard)

- Periodontal assessment must include:
  - recording of Pocket charting;
  - o recording of Plaque and bleeding scores;
  - Professional Mechanical Plaque Removal (PMPR) with subgingival scaling in areas over 4mm
- Treatment may include:
  - Subgingival instrumentation root surface debridement and removal of supra-gingival calculus if it impedes interdental cleaning via PMPR (professional Mechanical Plaque Removal)
  - o oral hygiene instruction:

- tooth brushing and interdental cleaning demonstrations, including asking the patient to practise;
- lifestyle modification advice, such as: diet, physical activity, smoking cessation, alcohol consumption
- A review, 3 months after treatment, must be carried out before either periodontal assessment and treatment (standard) or periodontal assessment and treatment (enhanced) can be claimed again for the same patient.

## Periodontal assessment and treatment (enhanced)

- Periodontal assessment must include:
  - pocket charting
  - o radiographs (if clinically necessary)
  - o recording of mobility
  - charting of bleeding on probing
  - charting of furcation lesions
  - o recording of plaque score
  - risk factors
  - behaviours
  - providing a treatment plan to the patient and explaining the patient's role in the treatment
- Treatment for managing non-responding sites may include:
  - Repeating subgingival instrumentation on moderate residual (4-5mm) pockets;
  - Deep residual pocketing (greater than or equal to 6mm);
  - Reinforce step oral hygiene instruction, risk factor modification and behaviour change advice;
  - o Alternative causes for should be considered at this stage;
  - Referral for pocket management or regenerative surgery should also be considered at this stage.
- A review, 3 months after treatment, must be carried out before either periodontal assessment and treatment (standard) or periodontal assessment and treatment (enhanced) can be claimed again for the same patient.
