## **Restorative and Surgical Treatment**

Filling (2 surfaces or less)

- Clinically necessary fillings for any tooth, including molars can be provided using any suitable material, except for:
  - patients up to and including 15 years of age and patients who are pregnant or breastfeeding, in which case amalgam fillings cannot be provided.
- Fillings must include the provision of any dressings, pulp capping or other preparatory treatment (including rubber dam) as required.
- Fillings, where clinically necessary, can be provided for both permanent and deciduous teeth.
- This cannot be claimed for the same surface within 11 calendar months of the original treatment.

## Filling (3 surfaces or more)

- Clinically necessary fillings for any tooth, including molars can be provided using any suitable material, except for:
  - patients under 15 years of age and patients who are pregnant or breastfeeding, in which case amalgam fillings cannot be provided.
- Fillings must include the provision of any dressings, pulp capping or other preparatory treatment (including rubber dam) as required.
- Fillings, where clinically necessary, can be provided for both permanent and deciduous teeth.
- This cannot be claimed for the same surface within 11 calendar months of the original treatment.

## Endodontic Treatment (Incisor/Canine/Premolar)

- This item may include:
  - the filling of a root canal of a permanent tooth with radioopaque filling material; and/or
  - the opening of root canal(s) for drainage, pulp extirpation, and/or incision of an abscess;
- This item also includes the provision of any necessary dressings and all other preparatory treatment.

## Endodontic Treatment (Molar)

- This item may include:
  - the filling of a root canal of a permanent tooth with radioopaque filling material;
  - the opening of root canal(s) for drainage, pulp extirpation, and/or incision of an abscess;
- This item also includes the provision of any necessary dressings and all other preparatory treatment.

# Temporary Crown/Bridge and Stainless Steel Crown

- Temporary crowns and bridges can be provided using any suitable material deemed clinically necessary.
- Stainless steel crowns can be provided for deciduous teeth.
- This item also includes the provision of any necessary dressings and all other preparatory treatment.
- This cannot be claimed alongside Crown Placement, Conventional Bridge or Resin Retained Bridge within a 12 month period.

#### Crown Placement

- Crowns can be provided using any suitable material deemed clinically necessary.
- This item also includes the provision of any necessary dressings and all other preparatory treatment.
- This item cannot be claimed:
  - by the dentist who provided the original crown, if a repair or replacement is required within 11 calendar months, unless it is required as a result of trauma;
  - alongside Temporary Crown/Bridge and Stainless Steel Crown within a 12 month period

#### Post/Core retention for crown

- any suitable material deemed required.
- This item can only be claimed alongside item Endodontic Treatment (incisor/canine/pre-molar) or Endodontic Treatment (molar)

#### Inlay/Onlay Placement

- Inlays/Onlays can be provided using any suitable material deemed clinically necessary.
- This item also includes the provision of any necessary dressings and all other preparatory treatment.

## Conventional Bridge (per unit)

- Bridges can be provided, for patients with stable and fully erupted dentition, at least 6 months after extraction, and subject to satisfactory periapical condition of the abutment teeth, periodontal status, general standard of oral hygiene and occlusion.
- Bridges should have an adequate retainer to pontic ratio normally not more than one pontic per retainer in cantilever bridges, two pontics per retainer in fixed movable bridges, and three pontics per two retainers in other bridges.
- This item includes:
  - all preparatory treatment required, including study models, dressings, pulp capping;
  - retainers;
  - o pontics in a suitable material deemed clinically necessary;

## Resin Retained Bridge (per unit)

- Bridges can be provided, for patients with stable and fully erupted dentition, at least 6 months after extraction, and subject to satisfactory periapical condition of the abutment teeth, periodontal status, general standard of oral hygiene and occlusion.
- Bridges should have an adequate retainer to pontic ratio normally not more than one pontic per retainer in cantilever bridges, two pontics per retainer in fixed movable bridges, and three pontics per two retainers in other bridges.
- This item includes:
  - all preparatory treatment required, including study models, dressing, pulp capping;
  - o retainers:
  - o pontics in a suitable material deemed clinically necessary;

## Extraction

- Extractions of permanent or deciduous teeth for adults and children
- This item includes all required post-operative care and advice.

# **Surgical Extraction**

- Surgical extractions of permanent or deciduous teeth for adults and children, which may include the removal of:
  - buried roots;
  - o an unerupted tooth;
  - o an impacted tooth, including those requiring bone removal;
  - soft tissue incision:
  - muco-periosteal flap
- This item includes all required post-operative care and advice, including the removal of sutures and arrest of haemorrhage.

## Sedation Assessment

 Provision of a sedation assessment according to current conscious sedation guidelines.

#### Sedation

- Provision of sedation using either:
  - o a single intravenous sedative agent; or
  - inhalation sedation (using a dedicated machine capable of delivering a fixed maximum level of nitrous oxide and a fixed minimum level of oxygen).
- This item can be claimed for any course of treatment where, in the opinion of the dentist, the treatment could not otherwise be carried out.

## Acrylic Dentures (partial)

- Provision of a partial denture in synthetic resin, which includes:
  - all necessary backing and name tagging;
  - the provision of all necessary clasps, rests and strengtheners;
  - o any adjustments needed within 6 months after completion.

# Acrylic Dentures (full)

- Provision of a full denture in synthetic resin, which includes:
  - o all necessary backing and name tagging;
  - the provision of all necessary clasps, rests and strengtheners;.
  - o any adjustments needed within 6 months after completion

#### Cobalt Chrome Denture

- Provision of a full or partial cobalt chrome denture, where an acrylic denture is not suitable for a patient. This should not be provided until a suitable period after extraction, normally 3 months. This includes:
  - all necessary backing and name tagging;
  - the provision of all necessary clasps, rests and strengtheners;
  - o any adjustments needed within 6 months after completion.

# Maintenance and Repair (restorative appliances)

· Adjustment, maintenance and repair of crowns, bridges, fillings.

# Maintenance and Repair (dentures)

- · Adjustment, maintenance and repair of dentures.
- This item cannot be claimed for adjustments within 6 months of completion of dentures.

#### **Splints**

## Acid etched splint

- Provision of an acid etched splint for the splinting of avulsed, luxated or mobile teeth, designed to allow primary healing to take place.
- This includes all necessary materials.

#### Laboratory made splint

- Provision of a laboratory processed hard or soft occlusal appliance used for diagnostic and/or therapeutic purposes in connection with parafunctional clenching, grinding of teeth and/or temporomandibular disorder.
- This includes all necessary materials.

## **Domiciliary**

**Domiciliary Visit** 

- Additional fee which can be claimed when a dentist provides a domiciliary visit, either at a patient's home or at a care home.
- This item can be claimed in addition to all the required items of treatment that are provided.
- This item cannot be claimed by GDPs providing enhanced skills in domiciliary care.
